Dear Mooring Holder:

Welcome to the 2017 boating season!

Harbor Master Les Bryant and Assistant Monet Brazier are eager to see you as we get closer to spring and boat launching season. Here are some important things to remember as we get closer to the summer boating season:

Mooring owners may purchase a key to the rest room for \$5 (non-refundable) – giving them 24-hour access. The door will be left unlocked when the Harbor Master is on duty.

Dinghy space continues to be very tight. This year when you bring your boat to the Harbor, please come and see the Harbormaster to get a dinghy sticker and assignment.

Annual fees must be received by the Town Office no later than April 27, 2017; if your fee isn't received by April 27th, a late fee of \$50 per mooring will be assessed. If mooring and late fees are not paid in full by May 31, 2017, the mooring site and mooring hardware will be considered abandoned.

Remember to have your mooring inspected every two years. This is for the safety of your boat and other boats, and for peace of mind. Moorings assigned with an ODD year are to be inspected this year. For more information, please see Section 7.8 of the Coastal Waters and Harbor Ordinance.
