- **Nomination Papers for Select Board, School Board, and Fire Chief are now available. Papers are due back April 12<sup>th</sup>.**
- As you may have noticed, the **Wastewater Treatment Feasibility Study** has been completed. It, along with an Executive Summary, can be found on the Town's website and at the Town Office. Here is the statement released by your Select Board:

"The Select Board has considered the study returned by Wright Pierce for the Waste Water Treatment Facility [Feasibility] Study as approved at Town Meeting. We do not believe at this time that it is in the Town's best interest to move this project forward. We believe the cost would be too high for the Town to absorb despite potential funding options. For this reason, we do not plan to bring it to a [Town] vote, at this time... We welcome citizen feedback."

- Make sure you check our website's calendar for updated meeting information. The first budget meeting scheduled for March 14<sup>th</sup> has been cancelled, so the first one will be the following Wednesday. Again, it's worth noting that Town Meeting is Saturday, June 16, 2018!
