The Select Board is working on next fiscal year's budget; debating various trash disposal options, starting a page by page review of the Comprehensive Plan, and finishing policy review. The Planning Board is working on site plan ordinance and land use ordinance reviews. They are also working on a glossary of ordinance definitions, with the expectation of standardizing them.

Last call for tax exemption paperwork, of all kinds. New or revised applications must be received by the Tax Assessor by April 1st.

Letters are being drafted for mooring holders. 2016 fees are not going up.

Democratic and Republican party caucuses are being held this month. If you are unenrolled, then you can enroll at a caucus. If you are not a registered voter yet, you can do that at a caucus. If you are a registered Democrat or Republican, it is too late to change your party.
