Request for Bids: Paving

The Town of Stockton Springs requests sealed bids for paving on the following roads:

- **Cape Jellison Road:** 20-ft. width for 6,500 ft. from a point near the Town Garage to the Cape Docks Road.
- **Cape Docks Road:** 20-ft. width for 1,050 ft., from the intersection of Cape Jellison Road to a marked point near the sharp corner.
- **Town Office Parking Lot, Current paved section:** 18-ft. width for 100 ft. length (as marked).

Scope of Services for all currently paved surfaces:

1. The roadway shall be swept;
 2. Apply one (1) coat of “tack” between the existing pavement and shim, with an application rate of 0.01 to 0.03 gal./square yard;
 3. Apply a shim coat of pavement $\frac{3}{4}$ inch depth with 9.5mm approved MDOT mix (verified by MDOT);
 4. Apply a wearing course of pavement with HMA 12.5mm mix, to an overall average depth of 1.5 inches rolled;
 5. All driveway aprons shall be paved and matched in.
- **Town Office Parking Lot, Gravel Section Only:** 2-inch loose layer of 12.5 Hot Mix Asphalt, with 1 inch 9.5, compacted to $\frac{3}{4}$ inch.

The successful bidder shall provide traffic control and proper signage at all times when work is in progress. Proof of insurance shall be submitted prior to the work beginning. The successful bidder shall notify the Town 24 hours prior to the work commencing.

Items to be CLEARLY stated in bid: Overall price and price per ton
 Evidence of insurability
 Expected dates for the start of work on each site

All paving work must be completed by October 19, 2018. The successful bidder shall provide tonnage slips daily to the Road Foreman.

Sealed bids, with envelopes marked “Paving Bid” and addressed to the Town Manager, Town of Stockton Springs, P. O. Box 339, Stockton Springs, ME 04981, must be received at the Stockton Springs Town Office by **4:00 PM, Wednesday, August 1, 2018**. Emailed submissions are to be sent to manager@stocktonsprings.org with “Paving Bid” in subject line. The Selectmen are expected to award the bid on or before August 16, 2018.

Stockton Springs reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids and to negotiate with the bidder who submits the most advantageous bid as determined by the Town.
