-***THIS SATURDAY is the third annual RUN FOR YOUR LIFE 5k & 12k road race.*** Please come out and support our Ambulance Service! - After 20 years of service, one of our ambulances has been retired and a new ambulance has been delivered. You can check it out this Saturday!

-NEW TOWN OFFICE HOURS- Beginning September 19, we will be open until 6:30 PM on Tuesdays.

-We have two foreclosed properties up for sale via sealed bid. One is on US Rt. 1 and the other on Mountain View Lane. The bid deadline is October 11, 2017 at 4PM. Anyone interested can find out more information on our website or by calling the Town Office.

-The Select Board is reviewing and considering entering an agreement with Sundog Solar and a third party to install solar panels on the Town Garage. This would lower our electricity bill with no upfront cost and an option to buy the unit 6 years from now (giving us time to save up). The Board will be making a decision on September 21st.

-The clerks will be unavailable on Thursday, September 28. They are attending a mandatory training that day. However, the Assessor and I will still be available, and the regularly scheduled Select Board meeting at 9am will be happening as scheduled.

-Tree cutting along Cape Jellison and Cape Docks Road in the Town's right of way is being done. I know it doesn't look great but give it a little bit of time and it'll green right up! This work is necessary to improve visibility and for paving prep (yes, Cape Jellison from the Town Garage up to Cape Docks road will be paved next year).

-As I mentioned last month, some of our shoreline at the Harbor had been washed away. Our Public Works crew did a wonderful job fixing it (see attached photo).
