6 1. Roll Call: Call to Order: Establishment of Quorum

7 Mr. Braga called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

13 3. Approval of Minutes from September 7, 2022

14 **Motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes from the September 7, 2022**
15 **meeting as presented. The minutes were approved without objection.**

16 4. Board E-Mail and Regular Mail Correspondence

17 There was no email or correspondence to discuss.

18 5. Old Business: Solar Project Update

19 Mr. Braga said that work had not begun on the solar project on McKenney Road as of
20 that day. Mr. Braga said that the construction permit is now expired.

21 6. New Business: Review Lighting Ordinance

22 Glenn Meadows, a Stockton resident from Fort Point Cove Road, spoke in favor of an
23 outdoor lighting ordinance for the town. He said he was a licensed civil engineer. He
24 volunteered to write the ordinance after Planning Board discussion. Mr. Poulin explained
25 the general path a proposed ordinance takes. Mr. Meadows requested that the Planning
26 Board meet privately to discuss the issue. The Board informed him that they could not
27 hold private meetings. Mr. Meadows spoke of the effect of excessive outdoor lighting on
28 Brown Tail moths and wildlife. He spoke of limits on residential outdoor lighting and the
29 measurement of light intensity. He spoke of the Night Skys initiative and the
30 measurement of residential
