New Business

- 1. Updated on Recycling, town and state.**

There has been talk of the town's E-Waste program being altered as to what will and will not be accepted at the monthly E-Waste monthly collection days – no clear answer yet from the town office. Recycling appears to be unchanged at this point. It was mentioned that some townsfolk are still placing their recycling in plastic bags which are not accepted. Beth and Sam will visit again with the town manager to get more details on E-waste and recycling status.

E waste collections – Beth reported that August was a busy month.

Empty small propane cylinders should be placed in the regular trash.

2. Recycling Banner – the banner is no longer hung in the downstairs meeting room where it was previously. Inquiry will be made concerning its whereabouts.
3. Discussions were held concerning the current difficult times with the presence of Covid, possibly filming future recycling committee meetings for posting on the town website and also possible methods to continue to get the word out to townspeople concerning recycling and E-waste collection.

Other: Heat Pumps – Beth reported that Jennifer stated that heat pumps were proposed for the Town Office - one upstairs and one downstairs. Wayne mentioned that the town should put heat pumps in next year's budget. Topic will be revisited with Jennifer.
