

STOCKTON SPRINGS RECYCLING AND ENERGY CONSERVATION COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Old Business

1. 8 November 2021 meeting minutes – read and approved.
2. E-Waste/Recycling reports – January, covered by Felicia, cancelled due to snow, February, Marti, wet and slow, March, no Henry, just Bruce. No known changes in current acceptable items for E-waste collection.
3. Heat pumps – Beth reported that the town has budgeted for and will be receiving the first heat pump to be installed by Solar Logic. A second and third heat pump will hopefully be acquired through rebates. Beth and Sam will meet with the town manager about the status of the plan to dedicate the heat pumps to former committee chair Cynthia Wells. Beth and Sam will also check with the town on heat pump installation timelines.

5. Paint disposal – Charlie will check on current paint (both oil based and other) disposal options and also what businesses participate in said disposal. The plan is to then post this information in one of the town's monthly newsletters.
6. Ink cartridge disposal – Beth will check with Susan Therio to see if she is still willing to take used ink cartridges to Staples for recycling. If so, Beth and Sam will check with the town about having a box in the town office for cartridge drop off.
7. Sam will check with Ray Smith about Window Dressers information for possible posting in the monthly town newsletter.

8. Annual committee report – Beth and Sam will check with the town manager concerning the due date for the committee’s annual report for the town report and then work on the report.
9. Beth inquired about someone replacing her as committee co-chair – no member volunteered to do so.
