1. Roll Call: Call to Order

Ryan King, who is an abutter to the Stockton Springs Elementary School building, spoke about realizing what the opportunity was in the building and property. He spoke of the need to get equity from the building for the taxpayers. He recommended that the building be recycled and not torn down. He said he and his wife were OK with that area being a transition zone. Sarah King asked about a time frame for the sale of the school. Another person asked why there was not an estimate for the cost of mold remediation other than the one provided by RSU 20. Ms. King said the cost for the estimate was prohibitive. Mr. Curley said there was a misconception that only a few rooms had mold, when in fact the whole building has mold and three rooms have it particularly bad. There was discussion of the part RSU 20 played in the current condition of the building. Kissy Wyman, a real estate agent, spoke of the importance of an appraisal. There was discussion of the amount paid by towns to the RSU 20 school system. Kenneth Wyman asked about the school budget. There was a discussion of whether the Town of Stockton was business-friendly.
