7 1. Roll Call: Call to Order

23 4. COVID-19 Update

25 Ms. King said the Town is still waiting to see if the stay-at-home order will be lifted on
26 April 30. Ms. King said she did not expect to hear anything official until April 28 or 29
27 based on the Governor's last stay-at-home announcement earlier in the month.

29 Ms. King said that e-waste had been cancelled for the month of April and that the need
30 for trash stickers were still being waived.

32 Ms. King said that Sandy Point Beach was still closed and that Public Works was putting
33 directional up signs on Hersey Retreat Road to help with parking concerns.

37 Ms. King gave an update on the building. She said the heat had been turned off because
