Minutes

1. Roll Call/Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m.

Present: Peter Curley, Betsy Bradley, Melissa Moody.

Also Present: Jennifer King – Town Manager.

2. Accounts Payable Warrant 72 and Payroll Warrant 73

**Motion was made, seconded and passed unanimously to approve Accounts Payable Warrant 72 and Payroll Warrant 73 as presented.**

3. Minutes

**Motion was made, seconded and passed unanimously to approve the minutes of the June 4, 2020 meeting as presented.**

4. Town Meeting Date

Ms. King announced that Town Meeting will be July 18 at the Town Office. She said she would be regularly giving updates as to how the meeting would be conducted. She invited residents to email her with questions.

5. Trash Stickers

There was discussion of the fact that there are no stores anymore that sell the town's trash stickers. There was discussion of the possibility of using just one trash sticker per week for all of a household's weekly trash pick-up. Ms. King said the cost of the new system would be worked into the budget.

6. Stockton Springs Elementary School

Ms. King said the Town had received two inquiries regarding a possible purchase of the former elementary school building. She said one was a party who was interested in obtaining the property free of charge in exchange for the building of senior housing. The second person, she said, had decided against trying to purchase the property.

32 Former Stockton resident Ruth Lind was in attendance representing Tranzon Auction  
33 Properties. Ms. Lind outlined the process involved if the Town went with an auction and  
34 the two different auction options. She outlined a process that involved the Town signing  
35 a contract with her company, the marketing of the property, and the on-line auction  
36 process. She explained the cost to the Town, including a marketing budget. Ms. Lind  
37 outlined the timeline if the auction option was pursued by the Town. There was  
38 discussion of having a special meeting to consider signing with the auction company and  
39 possibly taking action.
