Minutes

1. Roll Call: Call to Order

Present: Betsy Bradley, Peter Curley, Melissa Moody.

Ms. Bradley called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

2. Adjustments to the Agenda

An item was added for the Community Builders regarding a possible event at the harbor.

3. Community Builders

Jillian Liversidge described a possible outside event idea was presented to the Select Board. It would be a harbor party at Stockton Harbor, both on public land and at The Playground. She said there would be a food truck. The proposed hours were from 3-9 pm so that attendance would be more spread out. There would be no advertising outside of town, with the plan being that the event would be a get-together for residents. Masks would be encouraged. There might be a fireworks show. The system for counting attendees and ensuring the crowd did not exceed 50 was described. The event would be free. Ms. Bradley said she wanted to stay out of the discussion because she is involved with Community Builders. Mr. Curley said that though Community Builders did not request it, he did not think the Town should act as sponsor of the event. He said the fire department should be consulted if fireworks were planned.
