6 Roll Call: Call to Order

7 Ms. Bradley called the workshop to order at 9:10 a.m.

8 Present: Betsy Bradley, Peter Curley, Tom Fraser.

9 Also Present: Jennifer King – Town Manager, Mac Smith – Recording Secretary.

10 1. Select Board Member Concerns and Comments

11 Mr. Fraser asked about cigarette butts at Stockton Harbor and wanted to see it be a
12 designated Tobacco-Free Zone. Ms. King said she would look into it.

13 Mr. Curley asked if RSU 20 had gotten a bid for heating oil for the winter, which the
14 Town also purchases for Town needs. He said he wanted to get the amount of the bid.

15 Mr. Curley expressed concern about who would look after the cemetery on Church Street
16 now that Basil Staples had passed.

17 Mr. Curley asked about a recent Zoning Board of Appeals appointment and whether there
18 was a certificate of appointment made out for her.

19 Ms. Bradley said that someone she knows who has experience with HazMat-related
20 issues wanted to get into the Stockton Springs Elementary School building.

21 There was discussion of the upcoming special meeting at 2:30 p.m.

23 Ms. King said the Year 2020 is on-track. She said she would update the Select Board

29 alarm for the Stockton Springs Elementary School building regarding whether the Town
30 would be utilizing their service after the building was turned over to the Town. Ms. King
31 recommended continuing the service. She said the cost is \$600 per year. The Select
32 Board agreed it was best to continue the service.

33 Ms. King updated the Select Board on the Keep The Heat fund.

34 Ms. King said that the Town had received a 2018 bridge inspection report from the state.
35 She said the State had recommended repairs on the Eames Bridge on Green Valley Road
36 and the Meadow Ridge Bridge off Muskrat Road. She said that she had shared the report
37 with George Russell of Public Works.
