1. Select Board Member Concerns and Comments

Mr. Curley asked about the status of the Stockton Elementary School building. Ms. King said that the Town was waiting on the title. She said she had been in communication with the Town Attorney regarding the matter, and he felt the title should be ready by the first of the month.

Mr. Curley asked if there had been a response from the advertisement regarding volunteers being needed for various Town boards and committees. Ms. King explained further efforts at recruiting volunteers.

Mr. Curley asked about Air Bnb's. Ms. King said she is going to draft an ordinance for consideration at next year's Town Meeting.

Mr. Curley asked about dredging the fire pond on Harris Road. Ms. King said the project should begin in the fall.
