7 A.M. Curbside

Acceptable Items:

Metals and white goods, wood and furniture, floor coverings, and plastics. All items must be free of liquids, i.e.: petroleum, antifreeze, water, or oils. Any metal, for example: Stoves, refrigerators and freezers (doors must be removed or secured), microwaves, toasters, vacuum cleaners, radios, speakers, blenders, washers, dryers, metal or plastic gutters and gutter pipes, tin, bed springs, box springs, frames, headboards, mattresses, bicycle frames. Wood-Limited to one pile no bigger than 3ftx3ftx3ft and single pieces no longer than 3 feet. Stuffed chairs, couches, and other stuffed furniture, wood furniture, window frames with or without glass, porcelain (sinks, toilets, etc) rugs, linoleum, plastic (toys, lawn furniture, garden hose, etc)

Unacceptable Items:

Sheetrock, asphalt shingles, televisions, propane bottles, brush, branches, garden or lawn debris.

Tires; small quantities of rimless tires no bigger than 16" can be put out with trash on Fridays.

Televisions and computer monitors are not acceptable items for Spring/Fall Clean-Up, but they can be taken to the Town Garage on the last Saturday of each month from 9-noon for Universal Waste Drop Off Day.

Please have all items curbside, within 5 feet of the road surface, by 7A.M.

TRASH PICK-UP

- Trash pick-up is every Friday.
- Trash needs to be curbed side by 7 A.M.
- If you are having trouble with birds and animals getting into your trash, a trash can with a lid is recommended.
- Trash stickers are no longer required.

RECYCLING

- Recycling is the second and fourth Thursday of each month.
- Please ask us for a copy of our recycle list!
- We DO NOT have recycle bins any more. We recommend a trash can with a lid, and since we have single sort, all recyclables go in it!
- Cardboard can be put out with recyclables, or be taken to the cardboard dumpster at the Town Garage weekdays from 6A.M.-2P.M.
- **DO NOT use any plastic bags for recycling!** They are not recyclable, and they damage the sorter at the plant.
- Holidays falling on a Thursday may delay pick-up.
- At this time the Town Office will not be accepting ink cartridges, eye glasses, cell phones, or batteries.

UNIVERSAL WASTE DROP OFF DAY

The last Saturday of each month is Universal Waste Drop Off Day at the Town Garage from 9AM to noon. Stockton Springs residents can dispose of the following items:

- Computers, printers, modems, hard drives, monitors, televisions, scanners, fax machines, tablets, DVD and VCR players, microwaves, lamps, fans, toasters, and other electronics.
- Fluorescent lamps, coated lamps, crushed lamps, U-lamps, HID lamps.
- Batteries, cell phones.
- Ballasts, mercury containing devices.
- Waste oil, gas, transmission fluid, and fryer oil. (Also accepted at the garage weekdays from 6-2.)
- Styrofoam packing peanuts and shipping air bags, bubble wrap. (Also accepted at the garage weekdays from 6-2.)
